BROADWAY ACTOR, LOCAL AUTHOR TO PERFORM JULY 26

SOUTHPORT, Conn., July 7, 2008—Tony Award-winning actor Kristin Huffman will join local author, singer and businesswoman Linda Thompson for a performance of Broadway and popular songs, along with readings from Thompson’s new novel, “I Am My Own Dragon.”

This much-anticipated, free event will take place from 4:30 to 6:30 p.m. Saturday, July 26, at The Spa at National Hall, 20 Wilton Road, Westport. Guests will be treated to complimentary wine and cheese. Tours of the luxury spa and neighboring Inn at National Hall will also be offered.

Huffman, of Milford, earned a Tony in 2007 for her role in “Company,” which won “Best Revival of a Musical.” A former Miss Ohio and runner-up Miss America, she now gives private vocal and piano lessons, as well as teaches at the selective Hartt School and Performing Arts Center of Connecticut.

In addition to offering dramatic readings from “Dragon,” Thompson, of Southport, will read from her first published poetry collection, “Life As We Know It.” The collection features many of the same inspirational, encouraging themes found in “Dragon.”

A metaphysical, “fictional memoir” featured at Book Expo America 2008 in Los Angeles, “Dragon” is described by the Clarion Review as a story of hope and transformation that has the power to “jolt the reader out of complacency.” The book is written as a conversation between the reader and main character Lucy March, who asks readers to examine the “roadblocks” that may be holding them back.
